■ Book Description

This timely encyclopedia addresses the underrepresented scholarly State practices of the Asia-Pacific regions in negotiating and implementing the United Nations Convention on the Law of the Sea (UNCLOS): a continuing cornerstone of focus for regional and non-regional states alike. Further highlights for each represented State include ocean related treaty accessions, domestic implementation, maritime zones, maritime disputes, exploring and exploiting living and non-living resources, marine environment protection, marine scientific research, dispute settlement, and contributions to the progressive development of the law of the sea. The law of the sea is brought to life in the domestic laws, policies and institutions of States discussed.
