# The Third Workshop on Transport Statistics in East Asian Countries

In order to conduct research works for realization of the concept of the Seamless Asia, which is stated in "The New National Land Sustainability Plan (National Plan)", improvement of statistics of traffic and transportation is the major issue. The first and the second workshops on transport statistics in East Asian counties were held in March and November 2008 and current data issues of traffic and transportation statistics were discussed. In the workshop, importance of commoditization and standardization of traffic and transportation statistics was identified, and the course of action to be taken was proposed. This time, the presentation of country reports and free discussion for desirable transportation statistics will be organized, with experts of transport statistics from East Asian countries, in order to deepen discussions in the first and the second workshops.




